ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND:

SHDEPHA+ is an acronym for Service, Health, and Development for People living with HIV/AIDS. It is a national non-governmental organization, registered on 21 November 1994 with registration number SO 8216. SHDEPHA+ originated from the initiatives of fifteen people living with HIV/AIDS whose goal was to create a network and to mobilize resources to help people living with HIV/AIDS and to fight the spread of the disease. Although originally focusing on people living with HIV/AIDS, over the years SHDEPHA+ has expanded beyond HIV/AIDS and related issues to other development interventions and now covers both infected and affected by HIV/AIDs around 8 Regions of Tanzania Mainland.

SHDEPHA in Partnership with HJFMRI, Implementing Comprehensive HIV Care and Support Program in Mbarali DC. This partnership aims at reaching Three 95. First 95% of all people living with HIV know their HIV status, second 95% of all people diagnosed as being HIV Positive are enrolled to ART and third 95% of all people using ARVs are viral suppressed. Therefore SHDEPHA+ in Mbarali DC is implementing HIV/AIDS Care and Support Program in Twenty Wards (20 wards). Interventions fall in three main program areas such as Community Based HIV Services (CBHS) and HIV Testing and Counselling services (HTS) and HIV Prevention.

Through funding from Henry Jackson Foundation for Medical Research Institute (HJFMRI) SHDEPHA+ seek to recruit dedicated and qualified candidates for the Post of M&E Officer to work in Mbarali DC.
